

Open Prairie Natural Angus Beef Genotype Cattle Certification

All cattle eligible under genotype certification must have been sired by either:

- 1 registered Angus parent OR
- 2 registered Angus grandparents
- Both Black Angus and Red Angus are acceptable

The following steps must be completed to become genotype eligible for Open Prairie Natural Angus Beef:

- Confirm adequate records exist defining registered Angus parentage eligibility;
- Complete and sign genotype certification form; AND
- Submit genotype certification with pen or cattle certification affidavit to Tyson Fresh Meats Documentation must indicate
 - No more than 45 head per bull per calving season per ranch location;
 - Match the registered female with its offspring; <u>OR</u>
 - The number of registered sire semen straws equate to a minimum of one straw per calf in the group.

Tyson reserves the right to audit producer records to confirm certification accuracy.

Seller or duly appointed representative shall hold Tyson harmless against all damages, claims or liabilities arising out of or resulting in any way from inaccurate certifications. By signing this document, you acknowledge you have read and understand Open Prairie Natural Angus Beef Genotype Cattle Certification requirements. I will maintain such records for a period of 1 year after the date of this submission, and will make them available upon request. I certify that all statements made herein are true to the best of my knowledge.

Seller must fax this affidavit to 308-324-8150 prior to each load containing Angus cattle verified genetically through this process.
