Linda and I, along with our family, would like to welcome you to our 22nd Annual Montana Angus Female Bonanza.

As always, our philosophy and our PROGRAM from the very beginning has been to breed high quality Angus females to top quality Angus bulls that are bred alike, and that have some LOOK, PERFORMANCE, and MATERNAL momma cows behind them. Over the years we have come to believe if we were going to be successful not only breeding cattle, but also in merchandising and feeding cattle, our cattle must reflect this philosophy. We're proud that this offering of females represents our program in every way.

We are offering 1800 Angus bred heifers in this sale, of which 900 plus are AI bred to Vermilion Leo, and Circle L Unified. These bulls are the headliner calving ease bulls in the Vermilion Ranch program. A high percentage of the pasture bred heifers are carrying the service of low birth weight, high performing Vermilion Angus bulls. These heifers almost all originated out of the Vermilion Ranch program. A high percentage of the heifers are sired by Vermilion Ranch Bulls themselves. We know which ranch every heifer originated off of. Most all these heifers are carrying our V Bar brand on the left shoulder. These heifers are the front end of around 10,000 head we started with. They have been sorted for quality and disposition five times or more. **All bred heifers projected calving dates were figured on a 275-day gestation period.**

As always, a real feature in this sale are the near 1750 young bred Angus cows of which 1475 are 2 coming 3 year olds. All are bred to a Big Time set of high performing Vermilion Angus bulls. The bulls they are bred to really are special! These cows weaned a fancy set of calves and bred back with



an amazing 95% pregnancy rate. They are the REAL MONTANA ANGUS FEMALE BONANZA KIND!

All of the females have been Ultrasound pregnancy tested by Dr. Ralph Miller, the best in the business. This will be the largest volume of high-quality Angus females in America to sell that have been sexed and sorted into short day calving groups. There are two huge advantages to buying sexed females in tight calving groups: Number One, you have a very uniform calf crop and Number Two, and most importantly, your breed-up on these females the following year should be substantially higher than a set of females that calve for 60 days.
